PAF is a post-production supplier, providing audio description and subtitles for deaf and hearing impaired, while working at developing surrounding technologies.

PAF gathers a set of authors, blind and partially impaired people, art directors and voice actors, specialized in audio description of broadcasting medias.

Audio description conveys the visuals details of a work through a voiceover, inserted between the self-explanatory elements of a sound track.

PAF acts for a wider access to culture and medias for publics with special needs, with as a central criteria a quality of work and a technical production able to respect both the original artwork and the audience.
